Some of the things Jesus says are troubling because the meaning isn't obvious to all. For example, Jesus tells a story about a rich man building barns large enough to store his abundance of grain, but right before the building projects are finished, God shows up in the story and claims the mans life... Excuse me? That one's a thinker.

Other things Jesus says are troubling, not because their meaning isn't obvious, but because it is. "It would be better for them to be thrown into the sea with a millstone tied around their neck than to cause one of these little ones to stumble." (Luke 17:2) There's no question about what Jesus means. Protecting children is near and dear to Jesus' heart.



That's one of the reasons we're in the middle of reexamining our child protection policies and practices. It's a process we look at every few years to make sure our kids are able to learn about the love of God in a safe and comfortable environment.

One thing we've discovered is that it's time for lot of us who have been volunteering for years



redo our background checks so that we're all up to date. Moving forward, all volunteers

are going to have to get new background checks done every two years.

We're also adding a video training element to our process. Not only will the video remind each of us about the etiquette for serving with children, but it will also train us to be aware of early warning signs so that we're better equipped to be advocates.

As a reminder, by policy and practice, volunteers and ministers are never to be one-on-one with children. There's always another adult in the room, and when a child needs to use the restroom, we ask parents to take them and to change dirty diapers themselves. I understand the challenge that puts

on parents better than most. but I'm proud that we're prioritizing the safety and wellbeing of our children.

If you're a volunteer with the youth or children's ministries, then you'll hear more about the training and background check updates soon. If you're not yet a volunteer, then

e	children's ministry? You can. Extended Session takes place during the worship hour with children ages pre-K and under. They remain in the children's area with supervised godly play,
