About our Advent Theme

Joy is often a companion many other emotions. We ca feel joy in addition to feelin many other things at once grief, anticipation, anxiet excitement, disappointmen exhaustion. Perhaps many

us live with the myth that joy is not something we deserve—or that it is wholly out of reach. But our j is rooted in the truth that we belong to God. Can ye tether yourself to that deep truth? This theme of course alludes to a line in the famili Christmas hymn, "O Holy Night," which has interesting history. 


